

The Bloomington Board of Election Commissioners met at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday June 1, 2010. Chairman Esaw Peterson, Commissioner Jack Reidy, Commissioner Judy Green, Executive Director Paul Shannon, and Legal Counsel Bob Day were present.
